

OFF LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

ARLA Ref: 59/OFF/086/2019

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **NATALIE PAULA EDWARDS** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **7/1269 Christchurch Akaroa Road, Tai Tapu** and known as "**CROSS HARES**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS – SECTION 116 (2)

- (a) No alcohol may be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on ANZAC Day.
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered, on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine harvested from land on which the premises are situated, nor delivered contrary to sections 49 and 59 of the Act
- (c) Alcohol may only be sold or supplied on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday from 11.00am to 7.00pm

(d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:

- Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

(e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises concerned are observed:

- Alcohol must only be sold and supplied from within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

(f) The following step must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:

- The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in their host responsibility policy aimed at promoting the reasonable consumption of alcohol.

(g) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the licence holder and on any receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:

- (i) The licence holders name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires.
- (ii) A legible image of the licence, or clearly identified link to such an image must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site.

(h) The following steps must be taken to verify that people are over the purchase age:

- (i) In the case of an order made using an internet site the prospective buyer must declare by ticking an on-screen box, that he or she is 18 years of age (and where the prospective receiver is involved, that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over) –
- (ii) Once, when the prospective buyer first enters the internet site; and
- (iii) Again, immediately before the sale of any alcohol is completed.

The premises is to be **Undesignated**

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises situated at 7/1269 Christchurch Akaroa Road, Tai Tapu are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Selwyn District Licensing Committee on the 29th day of August 2019.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Christchurch Akaroa Road is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

(a) either -

- (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but


(b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –

- (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Subject to the requirements above, **the licence expires on the 4th of day October 2022**, unless again renewed.

NOTE: This licence replaces licence number 59/OFF/062/2018 issued by the Selwyn District Licensing Committee.
